## Directions to Wyoming Arts Center

### **From the South:**

Take I-75 North to the Galbraith Rd. exit (exit from the left lane.) Turn left at the light and proceed to the 2<sup>nd</sup> traffic light. Turn right onto Vine St. (which soon becomes Springfield Pike.) Go 0.9 miles and turn right onto Wyoming Ave. Three blocks down, the arts center is on the left corner at Grove Ave.

Parking available behind building on Grove or on the street.

### **From the North:**

Take I-75 South to exit 12 (the Lockland exit through the wall)– **slow down!** – it's more like a hard right turn! Turn right onto Cooper then left onto Wyoming. Turn right at Grove Ave.
