ATLANTIC CROSSING

For over a dozen years, the Vermont band *Atlantic Crossing* has been thrilling concert audiences and contra-dancers with traditional songs and acoustic instrumental music from New England—music which has deep Celtic roots in the British Isles and in French & Maritime Canada—together with original compositions inspired by these traditions.

Atlantic Crossing have appeared at numerous festivals, concert series, and on Public Radio. They have toured frequently in the USA and in the UK and, as a high energy contrdance band, they have played at many of the major US dance series as well as dance weekends. They now have five recordings to their name, the most recent, *Overtones & Undercurrents*, being released in 2009.

Rich harmonies and compelling rhythms imbued with a deep love of the traditions, high levels of creativity and emotional expression, and a healthy dose of fun are the hallmarks of an *Atlantic Crossing* performance.

Asheville, North Carolina caller Diane Silver is nationally known and has a penchant for hot modern contras with a few fun squares, thus providing a sizzling evening for experienced dance groups.

Her careful attention to dancers' pace and progress, the ability to think on her feet, and clear efficient teaching of higher-level dances ensures fun for everyone in mixed-level groups.

Her great positive energy and spirit of community – building also helps to create a fun, low risk atmosphere for beginning dancers to get up and give it a try.

Her easy-going, friendly teaching style and remarkable skill in breaking down moves and explaining dance in different ways for different learning styles.

Her flexible calling style matches well with either New-England / Celtic or Old-Time style bands, and their derivatives.
